BENEFEDS

BENEFEDS is a government authorized and OPM sponsored enrollment portal that is used to enroll in, get information about and make changes in the Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Plan (FEDVIP), Long Term Care (FLTCIP) and Flexible Spending Accounts (FSAFEDS).

CSA, CSF - What Does it Mean?

If you have had any dealings with OPM, a CSA or CSF was one of the first pieces of information that you were required to provide. Just like your Social Security number is your personal U. S. national identification number, your CSA or CSF number is your Office of Personnel Management personal identification number. It is a unique assigned number that is used to identify the retirement (annuity) account and accrued benefits. The "CS" stands for Civil Service. It is a seven digit number that is included on all correspondence from OPM. When you retire OPM will send you a Welcome Letter with a retirement card that contains your CSA number.

If you are an annuitant you will be issued a CSA number. If you are a survivor, OPM will issue you a CSF number after the notification of death is processed.

When logging onto your *Services OnLine* account you will need your OPM provided password. The CS will be pre-filled. If you are signing on as a retiree, the first letter that you will type will be "A", followed by your 7 digit claim number, followed by "0". If you are a survivor the first letter that you type will be "F", followed by your 7 digit claim number, followed by "W".

OPM OPEN SEASON

Open Season runs from **November 8 - December 13**. The annual Open Season gives federal employees, annuitants and other eligible individuals the opportunity to review their FEHB and FEDVIP plans, make changes and enroll for the upcoming benefits year that begins January 1, 2022.

OPM Announce 2022 Health, Dental, and Vision Program Premiums

The U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) announced the 2022 plans and premiums for the Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Program and the Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP). In the midst of fighting the COVID-19 pandemic, OPM and the federal benefits carriers have worked closely to negotiate benefits and rates for the 2022 plan year. OPM continues to focus on offering quality health, dental, and vision benefits that are affordable to the entire federal family.

The average total premiums for current non-Postal employees and annuitants enrolled in plans under the FEHB Program will increase 2.4 percent for plan year 2022, the second lowest premium increase in the last 24 years. Under FEDVIP, the overall average premium for dental plans will increase by 0.81 percent, and the overall average premium for vision plans will increase by 0.95 percent.

The FEHB Program features 275 health plan choices for 2022. OPM asked FEHB carriers to focus on COVID-19, mental health, and substance use disorder service in response to the opioid epidemic.
