Morgan Canterbury from Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield was our guest speaker.

She reviewed information in the brochure <u>2023</u> <u>Medicare and Blue.</u>

Basic and Standard Options had rate increases. Blue Focus did not, but doesn't cover some prescriptions.

Pharmacy benefits are on Page 4. Be sure and check out the cost of co-pays in each Tier under each option.

Pages 7 and 8 have details on incentive programs such as the Blue Health assessment, online health coach, and additional wellness programs. Basic Option still has the \$800 reimbursement payment for Part B Medicare.

<u>Dental</u> coverage rates went down and there is no change in benefits. <u>Vision</u> coverage rates went down and refraction is now covered up to \$39. For dental and vision coverage, you can cancel your enrollment each year and/or switch carriers each year.

Ignore Medicare Advantage solicitations.

The 50/50 (Alzheimer's Fund) drawing was won by Garnet Hypes. The gift basket drawing was won by Wanda Ware.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:24 p.m.
