The following is from FEDWeekly Issue Wednesday April 30

House Panel to Vote on Raising Required Retirement Contributions while Lowering Benefits.

A House committee is set to vote this week on a Republican leadership-crafted package that would degrade the value of retirement benefits for federal employees retiring after an unspecified date, while requiring about half of them to pay more toward those benefits.

The Oversight and Government Reform Committee action will come in response to recent passage by both the House and Senate of a budget outline through 2034 reflecting Trump administration priorities on tax and spending policies. That measure requires that committee to produce \$50 billion in deficit reduction over that period.

Its recommendations, along with those of other committees, are then to be assembled into a wide-ranging "reconciliation" bill that will require only a simple majority vote in the Senate for approval, rather than the usual 60-vote threshold for major legislation there.
